Production

From our first motor manufactured in 1961 to over 10 million motors manufactured every year.

- The world's largest electric motor manufacturing plant is in Jaragua do Sul, Brazil
- Power of all generators manufactured by WEG equals over 32,000 MVA (twice Itaipu's hydroelectric plant capacity)
- Over 1,250 tons of powder coatings and 800 tons of liquid coatings are produced each month






